

■ Inward And Outward Writing Intensive 5-Day Workshop

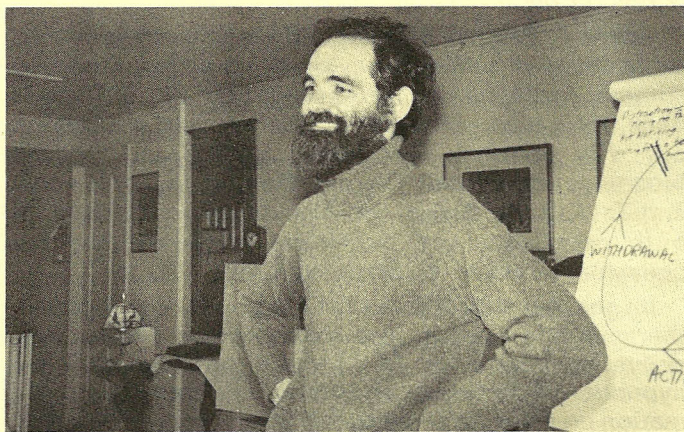

In this workshop we present theory and techniques, create feedback groups, and provide time for writing.

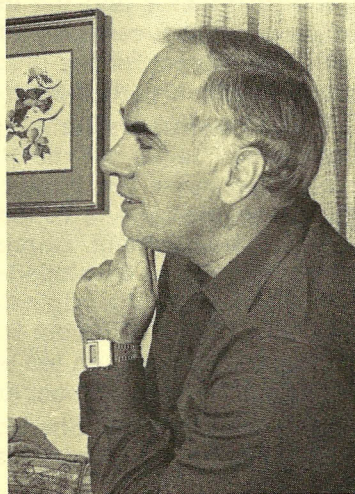

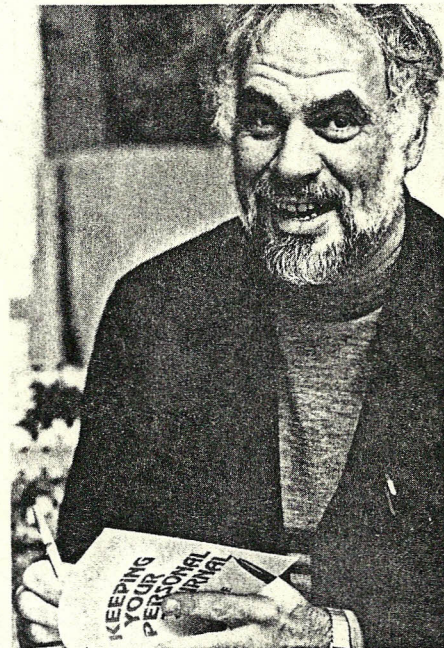
