

Instructions for Visiting diversophy® 3D Campus in Second Life

- Check the system requirements first: <http://secondlife.com/support/system-requirements/>

- **STEP 1**

- Go to step 2 if you have a Second Life account. If you do not have a Second Life account, please create one by following this link: <https://join.secondlife.com/>

Fill in all your data, think about a first name for your avatar, choose a last name from the list and create your Second Life look. After creating an account, activate it by clicking on the link in the confirmation email you receive. *Creating and accessing a Second Life account is completely free. Next steps:

- Download Second Life Viewer 1.23 (links below), not viewer 2. Once the download is finished, run the installation.

- Download the Second Life client viewer 1.23. Once the download is finished, run the installation. Welcome to Second Life!
- After successful installation, start the Second Life client and log in using your Second Life name and password. First you will arrive in the Welcome Island which gives you general instructions on how to move about in Second Life.

STEP 2

- If you have an avatar and you are ready to go to diversophy® 3D Campus, click the link below and get teleported directly to Bluepill Island's Landing Point: <http://slurl.com/secondlife/Bluepill/224/217/95/?title=diversophy%20HUD>

- Alternatively, you can also search for the bluepill GROUP Island in the Second Life viewer by following these steps:
 1. Click on the “Map” button at the bottom of the Second Life Client.
 2. Type “bluepill” in the empty field.
 3. Click on the “Teleport” button.
- Once on the main Bluepill Island, you will see three panels next to each other.



- Go towards the last panel (image above and below) and locate the one that says “Campus 3D diversophy HUD.” Click on it.



- Next you will arrive in front of the Campus 3D Station:



- If you do not see it, move around your avatar to locate it using your keyboard arrows.

1 Click on “Get your HUD” button on the station and then click on “keep” to the message that appears.

- 2 Then walk behind the Campus 3D Station to see images and instructions for attaching the HUD. You can also follow these steps:
 - Click on “Get your HUD” and then click on “keep” to the message that appears.
 - Click on your inventory (at the bottom of the page or a suitcase image on the right if you are using viewer 2), then locate “Objects” and click on it.
 - Find the diversophy HUD 1.32 beta and right click on “wear.”

It is important that you wear it.

- Once you are wearing it, you will get a message welcoming you to the HUD.
- Welcome to the Campus 3D HUD!
- The Welcome Panel will appear to the left of the 3D Station HUD panel (it may take a few seconds to load, so be patient). When you see it, you will be ready to have a go at the games - simply press on the “Start” button at the bottom of the Welcome Panel, then choose the country of your interest and click on “Do course.” There are about 100 or more questions per course if you have full access. If you haven’t bought the full course, you can do a demo (8 questions on each culture).
- **NB!** To have your HUD working properly, please use viewer 1.23, not viewer 2.

Please note the following when playing:

- Pressing the “STOP” button will terminate your active course. You will have to start from the beginning.
- Pressing the “PAUSE” button will pause your active course and show you the *Overview Course* screen when you resume the quiz.
- To resume the course you paused, simply select the course on the *Overview Course* screen. You will return to the same question where you paused earlier.
- You have 150 seconds to answer each question. If your time runs out, your test will also end.
- Once you have completed an exercise, you will see your final score on the HUD.
